# ALLIANCE ANNUAL CELEBRATION

In March of 2014, the MetroHartford Alliance's Annual Celebration held a special significance - the organization had worked with a Strategic Partner, Mintz + Hoke, Inc. based in Avon, Connecticut, to develop a new logo that would better embody the Alliance's vibrancy and multifaceted work. The Annual Celebration, an event that gathers several hundred Investors and community partners to network and learn about the accomplishments of the year past, would serve as the logo's formal unveiling.

The event came at a time when the organization was also in the midst of renovations for its offices. Staff had relocated to a neighboring floor in the home building, and awaited a return to a refreshed space. A new marketing campaign for the City of Hartford had also kicked into high gear, and provided the impetus for a shift away from the organization's then-current logo and a move to embrace a mark of a more timely and forward-looking nature.

More than 400 registrants came through for the Annual Celebration - a record in several years - which was billed as an opportunity to see the formal unveiling, as well as a chance to gain deeper insight into the organization's efforts to promote the Region and support its competitiveness for **jobs, capital and talent**. The program for the evening featured a video presentation that spoke of the Alliance and its initiatives from the vantage of Investors and community partners. Alliance president and CEO, Oz Griebel, used the video as a springboard to share the strategic goals for the year ahead and introduced towards the end of the program an animation that transitioned the old logo into the new.

Every facet of the event saw integration of the new mark, from the name badges for attendees to the scarves and ties that Alliance staff wore that evening. The program and overall event was a true team effort, and would not have been possible if not for the expertise of Alliance team members in combination with external vendors with whom the Alliance shares a strong bond.
